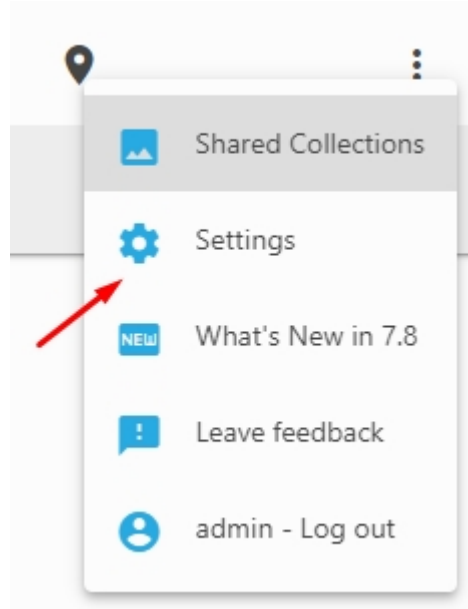


To customize Daminion's Web Client interface and adjust it to your brand, click the three small dots on the toolbar, and then click Settings. If you logged in as Admin, the Settings

1 Color scheme: Set up a color scheme here for the current catalog and a default color scheme for all catalogs.
