

Before starting autotagging, you must enable it in the admin panel, please follow [this article](#) Once the feature is enabled, auto-tagging can be done both in the Web Client, and the Desktop Client.

Please read the article about [the difference between AI labels and AI objects](#) to better understand what is written below. The Ai Object feature has been available since version 8.1.

Auto-tagging in the Web Client

To start auto-tagging your files in the Web Client, select the desired files and choose

'Generate AI Tags' from the drop-down menu.



It can take some time to generate tags.

To see how many files are in the tagging process, open the main menu and select AI tagging progress.



As a result, AI Labels and AI Objects will be assigned to the selected files.



AI tags generation can also be launched right during the import process.



To change the language of the AI tags, go to the Settings > Integrations menu and select a

language from the list.



Auto-tagging in the Desktop Client

To generate Auto-tags using the Desktop Client, select the desired files, right-click on one of them, and select 'Generate AI Labels / Ai Objects' from the Actions menu.



The following window will appear:



To confirm, click OK, or select additional tagging options by clicking the Settings button.

The following options will be available:



 AI Labels options:

- Generate tags for unprocessed files.

Generate tags only for files that have never been tagged with AI via Daminion.

- Generate tags for all files, including those already processed

Tag all files, even if they already have AI tags. New tags will also be added .

- Update tags according to Relevance Score

Update tags according to the score value set in the admin panel.

In this case, all tags that were in the file will be filtered out based on their relevance score.

The tags below the score will be removed from the file.

- Do not generate tags

This option in the “AI Labels” and “AI Object” sections is useful if you want to assign AI Labels or AI Objects only.

AI Objects options:

The option descriptions are identical to that of the AI Labels..

You can use the checkbox to choose whether or not to translate the tags

See here how to choose languages for translations

You can select any combination of these options. For example, generate only AI labels without translation, or update only AI object tags.

Note: If a new language for auto-translation of tags is selected, select the options as shown in the screenshot below to translate all the tags in your catalog:



Once set, go to View > Language, and select a language from the list to change the language of the AI tags.



Note: AI tag language settings are the same for the web and desktop clients.
